Dear Sir or Madam,

we are delighted that you made the decision to visit our museum with your class. We are convinced that you made the right choice to bring the theme „volcanism“ closer to your pupils in a professional and exciting way.

To ensure that other visitors have as much fun as you and your class, we kindly ask you to observe the following instructions:

1. The Lava-Dome is an interactive museum and we offer a lot of exhibits. You can try things out, by yourself here. Unfortunately, these exhibits are very often overused. Repairs are usually very expensive. We therefore ask you to supervise the activities.
2. You and your class are rarely alone in our museum. We therefore ask you to be considerate of other visitors. We are no "whispering museum" and we do not want to be. However, running after people, excessive shouting or even physical disputes do not belong here and disturb our other visitors. We therefore ask you to supervise your pupils outside the guided tour of the Lava Dome at all times.
3. Also vandalism in our toilets is a major problem, especially in the men's toilets. Deliberate blockages of the toilets and urinals are unfortunately almost a daily occurrence after school visits. We therefore ask you to inform your pupils that we are willing to identify the person and charge the costs incurred accordingly.
